APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Send your completed application form, along with your personal testimony and a non-refundable application fee of \$25.00 (\$10.00 for auditors) directly to NEBC.
2. Have written references mailed directly to NEBC as follows (all references must be from *non-family members*):
 - Degree students (B.A., B.S., and A.A.): three references (one pastor/church leader, two Christian friends)
 - Certificate students: two references (one pastor/church leader, one Christian friend)
 - Special students and audit students: (provide names of references)
3. Provide *official* high school transcripts or evidence of GED as follows:
 - Have your high school send an official transcript directly to NEBC. A transcript request form is available.
 - GED graduates must have an official score report sent to NEBC.
 - Home schooled students must submit a transcript with courses names, grades and a cumulative G.P.A. NEBC may request further information as necessary.
4. Request your SAT scores to be sent directly to NEBC. The NEBC school code for SAT is 5727. Applicants who have more than 15 transferable college credits may submit *official* college transcripts in lieu of SAT scores.
5. You may be asked to have an interview prior to admission
