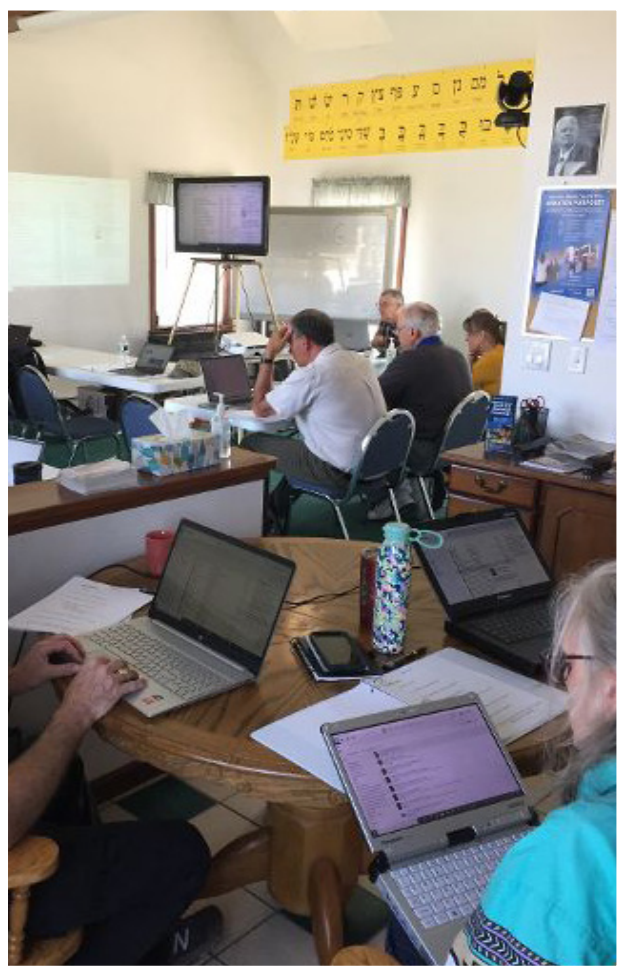

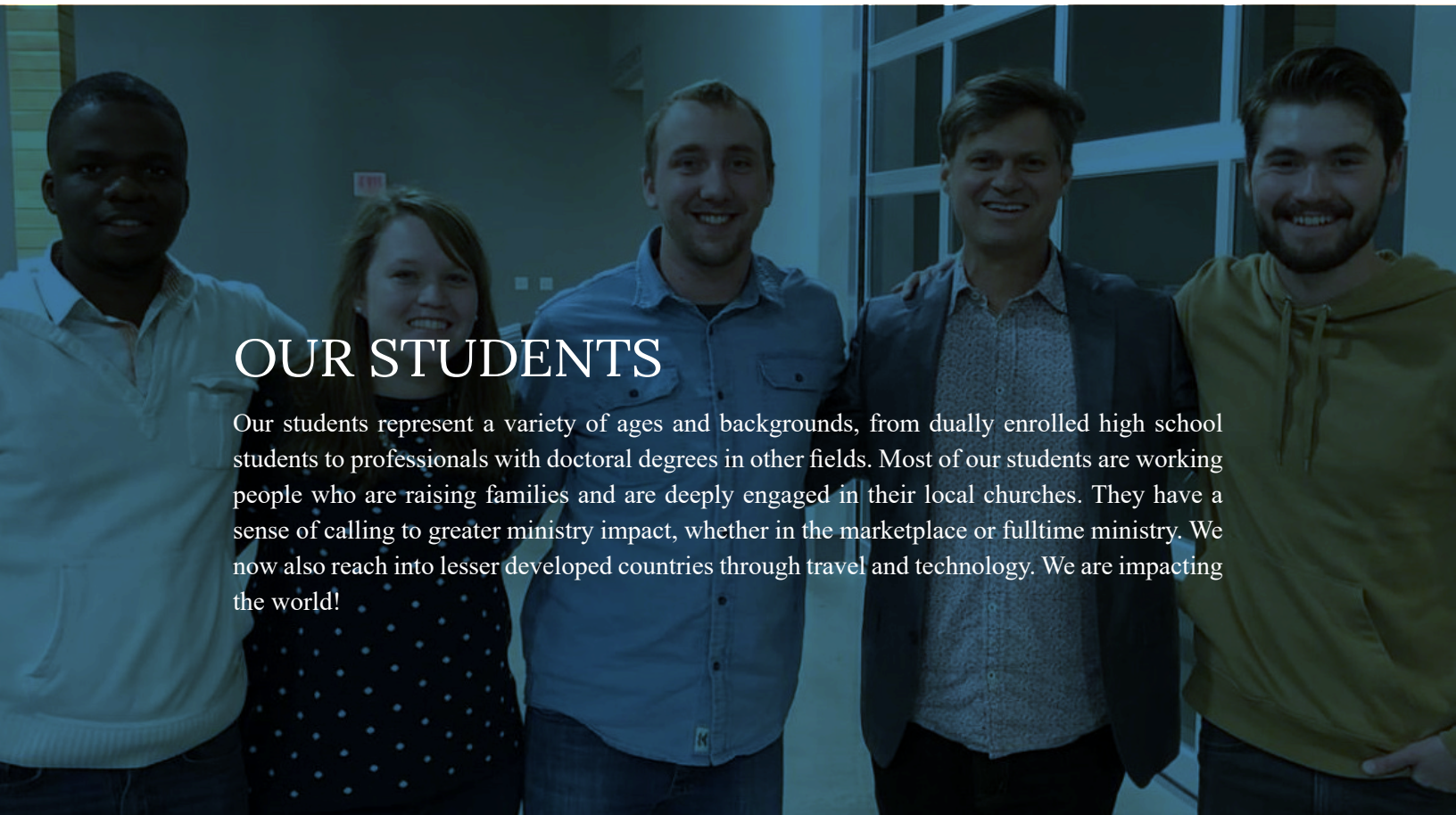
New England Bible College & Seminary was formed through the merger of two evangelical Maine colleges – New England Bible College and Grace Evangelical Seminary. We have equipped ministry and marketplace leaders throughout Maine and beyond for over 65 years. NEBCS provides biblically faithful, academically rigorous, and practical ministry education. Scripture teaches us to pass on what we have been taught (2 Timothy 2:2). This passage offers a missional objective that runs four generations deep – Paul, Timothy, those Timothy taught, and those they taught. NEBCS exists to extend that same model to future generations in New England and beyond.

OUR VISION

Our vision is to aid the local Church in producing thoughtful, transformative servant-leaders for the Body of Christ who will revitalize churches, plant new churches, and expand great commission impact in the church and marketplace, leading people into a rich and reproductive relationship with Jesus Christ.

OUR STUDENTS

Our students represent a variety of ages and backgrounds, from dually enrolled high school students to professionals with doctoral degrees in other fields. Most of our students are working people who are raising families and are deeply engaged in their local churches. They have a sense of calling to greater ministry impact, whether in the marketplace or fulltime ministry. We now also reach into lesser developed countries through travel and technology. THE NEBCS EDUCATION

While students can earn certificates all the way through Masters Degrees, NEBCS is more concerned about education and preparation than strictly passing out degrees. We prepare people to effectively serve Christ in the 21st century while remaining firmly planted in the classic, historic, evangelical theological bedrock of Scripture. We ground students in the core tenets of the Christian

faith while encouraging them to form their convictions following their own ecclesiastical heritages. Most of our professors hold doctoral degrees and are also practitioners as pastors, missionaries, counselors, educators, and leaders in various ministries or the marketplace. Students will experience an outstanding education that is biblically rooted and missionally focused.

THE NEBCS ADVANTAGE

Our non-traditional, in-person/online and asynchronous classroom learning has expanded our reach with 60% enrollment growth in the last year. Students choose NEBCS for these key reasons:

LOW COST/HIGH VALUE. We are dedicated to being one of the country's most affordable Bible Colleges and Seminaries while maintaining a high standard of spiritual and academic excellence. We seek ways to keep our costs low and students debt-free through scholarships made possible through essential partnerships and maintaining low overhead.

CONVENIENCE. Since 2023, NEBCS has made all its education available online as either Live In-Person/Zoom courses or an ever-growing complement of fully online asynchronous courses built by NEBCS or in partnership with other Bible Colleges. People can complete their education without uprooting their lives.

PATHWAYS. NEBCS offers educational pathways to earning low-cost unaccredited degrees or slightly higher-cost accredited degrees in official partnerships with colleges like Lancaster Bible College | Capital Seminary, Cairn University (and up to 30 others). Students can choose a low-cost and equipped-for-ministry education or a higher-cost and accredited education.

LOCAL CHURCH ENGAGEMENT. By remaining in Maine or near their home locale, students can stay involved in their local churches, maintaining the opportunity for excellent hands-on ministry involvement while they receive their academic preparation.
